

Great River School 2010-11 Supply Lists

Please note: GRS encourages students to consider the environment when purchasing school supplies. Please reuse materials from last year (i.e. a notebook with clean pages & binder) if possible. Purchase wooden pencils instead of plastic mechanical ones.

Materials to purchase from School:

Planners: \$5 charge per student to cover the cost of a GRS academic planner,
Portfolio Binder * * * NEW STUDENTS ONLY * * *: \$10 to purchase a binder for your portfolio.

Art Materials: \$15 for materials if a student wishes to purchase a package of the supplies needed for art. (Schedules will be available on September 1 at Orientation to help students know whether they will need these supplies)

Mead Notebook: \$2 for use in core classes throughout the year.

Please bring cash or check on September 1 OR to the front desk by October 1 (cash or check payable to Great River School) with the form on the back.

Reinforced Composition Paper

If you are a student who struggles with organization and often has composition paper (lined paper) ripping, tearing, and/or falling out of your binders, then consider purchasing the reinforced composition paper with a plastic strip over the holes.
